Key Questions & outcomes:

Who was Frida Kahlo?

She is considered one of Mexico's greatest artists

Where did she live?

She lived in Mexico and was born in Mexico City.

When did she live?

She was born on July 6, 1907 and died July 13, 1954. She was just 47 years old.

Why do we remember her?

She never gave up on her dreams and became an icon.

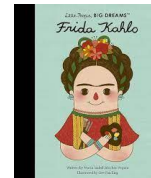
How do we remember her?

We remember her self-portraits and bold, vibrant colours. She is celebrated in Mexico for her attention to Mexican and indigenous culture and by feminists for her depiction of the female experience and form.

Key vocabulary we will learn:

Feminism - full social, economic, and political equality for women

- **Art:** Frida Kahlo work- Printing 2 colours/ repeating
- **Science:** Working Scientifically- Planning own experiments
