As a part of your child's educational experience at Huntington Primary Academy we aim to promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive programme of Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education that gives children and young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live healthy, safe, productive and fulfilled lives, both now and in the future.

Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), along with Health Education is now statutory and forms part of the National Curriculum. The coverage of our RSE curriculum has not changed from last year as we believe our PSHE provision is appropriate for our pupils but we would like to reshare this information with you.

Attached is a copy of our PSHE progression map, which explains what we teach in the school and when. This information is also available on our website. The RSE curriculum threads through the entire year. However, during the Summer term the Health and Wellbeing section will be taught - this includes puberty for Years 4, 5 and 6.
